RESIDENT UPDATES

Rent Checks

For all rent checks please make payable to THE FALLS IN HUDSON INC. We have added a Check Drop Box in our main lobby. It is located right by the front desk.

Guest Parking Pass

If having a visitor for 2 or more consecutive nights, be sure to pick up your Guest Parking Pass at the front desk. Guest parking is located to the right of the main entrance, near the Banquet Hall. This pass must be displayed on the front dashboard of the guest's vehicle. Please return pass to front desk after use.

Storage Unit Access

As of Friday, September 22nd all residents will have key fob access to the storage units! The storage units will be open 7am-7pm, Monday through Sunday. All access will be from inside the building, the far entrance in the West Wing on the first floor. It's the door located below the stairs, immediately to the right after the double doors. If you need access from the outside entrance, please submit a maintenance request.

Guest FOBs

Guest key fobs are available for purchase. If interested it costs \$25.00 per key fob. We need the following information for the visitor: Name, vehicle information, email address, and telephone number. It will be given "Guest Access" only. That means it allows them to enter only through the side door by our main entrance, next to the intercom. The hours for "Guest Access" are from 6am-11pm. They key fob will only work during these hours, seven days a week. We can either charge your account for the additional key fobs, or you can leave a check at the front desk.

Visiting Animals

If any resident has a guest that is bringing an animal during their visit to the building, please adhere to the following guidelines. For everyone's safety, we require the visiting animal's vaccination record along with \$100 non-refundable pet fee. The fee may be charged to your account online, or a check may be dropped at the front desk. Please make checks payable to The Falls in Hudson, INC. All information along with the fee must be received PRIOR to the animal's visit.

Lobby Carts

We are happy to now provide 3 hotel carts to assist with moving items from groceries, deliveries, heavy items, etc., located by our front desk in the main lobby. As a reminder, we ask that when you do use the cart to please RETURN TO THE FRONT DESK.

Locked Out?

We have installed an emergency key box in our main entrance by the postal boxes. Call/text the first number and you will receive a code to enter the building. Please remember this is for emergency lockouts ONLY. We suggest taking these steps before using emergency box:

Call the front desk (518)719-1600 ext.130. If during business hours we are always happy to help.
"Buzz your Bud"- Have a friend in the building you can call if you get locked out or forget your fob.

Favorite food: Grated parmesan cheese on her food


Nicknames are: Goose, Goosey Dog, or Gooby.

17th Annual Ghostly Gallop Fall Classic
