RESIDENT UPDATES

Low Humidity in Apartment

A great feature about your thermostat is it informs you of the humidity level in your home. If humidity levels are too low in a home, such as in dryer climates, it can result in dry and bloody noses, sore throats and dry skin. Drier air also makes you more susceptible to becoming sick. This can occur especially in the winter when the heating system is running frequently. Any home, this time of year, should be 40 to 60% humidity. To assist with raising the level of moisture in your apartment we suggest the following:

- 1. Purchase a humidifier
- 2. Monitor your thermostat.
- 3. Placing a large pot of water on to simmer, it will release moisture into the air.
- 4. Add live houseplants.
